WASHINGTON STATE USBC ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT RULES

- ELIGIBILITY:** All bowlers must be members of the United States Bowling Congress, having obtained membership through a local association within the jurisdiction of the Washington State USBC Association (WSUSBC). Non-USBC members may establish eligibility by purchasing an associate membership. Nonresidents not showing proof of membership obtained through a local jurisdiction of the WSUSBC may be required to purchase an associate membership.
- AVERAGE REQUIREMENT/VERIFICATION:** Entrants will use their highest USBC or CTF certified league yearbook or association average based on the 2010-2011 season with a minimum of 21 games, including summer league average. If the bowlers have no qualifying average from 2010-2011 than they may enter using their highest 2011-2012 average for 12 or more games at the time of bowling. **USBC Rules 319(d) and 319(e) apply in this tournament**, all others bowl scratch. Average verification must be submitted prior to bowling if a bowler's confirmation has an asterisk next to his/her name. Failure to use the proper average or to make correction prior to, or before, completion of the first game of any event shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average, or base prize winnings on submitted average if higher. **Entrants without a verified average will automatically be assigned an average of 230. USBC Rule 319a (2) does not apply.**
- BOWLER RESPONSIBILITY:** It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, team captain or others. If the submitted average is higher than actual average, prize winnings will be based on submitted average, per USBC Rule 319a-3.
- RESERVATIONS/CLOSING DATE:** All teams holding reservations must check in at the tournament office no later than 1 (one) hour prior to the scheduled time for bowling. All bowlers must present their USBC cards at check in. Entries close during the last squad at 12:30 pm, May 20, 2012.
- ENTRY FEES/PAYOUTS/RETURNED CHECK CHARGES:** **Entry fee is \$75.00 per Team. Prize fund - \$12.00; lineage and expenses - \$13.00 per person. Payout 1 in 6. Prize fees will be returned 100%. A fee of \$35.00 plus bank fees will be charged for any checks returned by banks, credit unions, etc, for all prize checks that need to be reprinted due to being lost, ruined, etc., a fee of \$35 will be charged for the stop payment fee at the bank.**
- HANDICAP:** 90% of 690 scratch.
- MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** A bowler may participate as many times as he/she wants in the Trios event, providing one team member changes on the roster.
- PROFESSIONAL BOWLER ASSOCIATION (PBA & PWBA) MEMBERS:** Not more than one professional bowler will be allowed to bowl on a Trios team. A professional bowler is defined as a bowler who holds a membership card in the PBA or PWBA.
- ERRORS/SCORES LOST:** All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the secretary within 48 hours after the bowler or team has bowled. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game that are irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with the approval of the Tournament Manager, per USBC Rule 327c.
- No teams may begin bowling prior to, or later than, the listed time. Tournament Manager has the discretion to allow or not allow a team to start a few minutes after scheduled time. There should be 2 teams per pair of lanes to start.
