Tournament Rules

1. USBC Youth Division rules and regulations will govern the tournament. All entrants must be eligible under USBC Rule 400.
2. Entry Fee will be \$16.00 per person/per event.
3. Classifications are as Follows: (According to Average)

4. **TEAMS:** All teams shall be composed of four (4) members; mixed entries will be allowed and classified according to average. All entries must list and pay for four members. No partial teams accepted. No team member may switch teams unless team he/she comes from is dissolved. Bowlers may bowl team event two (2) times. Teams may have no more than two (2) of the original members.
5. **DOUBLES AND SINGLES:** Bowlers may bowl singles or doubles or both. Bowler may enter **only once** in singles. Bowlers may bowl doubles three (3) times, but must change partners each time. All double entries must list and pay for two (2) members. Bowlers may enter optional scratch division by circling "S" in singles/doubles fields on entry form. **If bowling in both events, singles will be bowled first and doubles will follow on the same squad, unless prior arrangements have been made.**
6. **HANDICAP:** Handicap will be based on 100% of 200.
7. **PAYMENT:** No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by a business, association, center or league check, certified check or money order for the full amount due on the entry and made payable to the Washington State USBC or processed online. **NO PERSONAL CHECKS ACCEPTED.** Advance Reservations will be accepted until January 31, 2012. No Collect calls will be accepted.
8. **ENTRY DATES:** Opening date for entries will be January 1, 2012. All entries must be **postmarked** no later than the first business day after March 30, 2012, and include full payment or they will not be accepted. Returned checks shall be subject to a **\$25.00 service charge. Funds must be secured on any returned check prior to the start of the tournament; otherwise, bowler(s) paying by such check will not be allowed to participate.**
9. **ENTERING AVERAGE:** The average to be used for this tournament will be in the order of:
 - a. Highest average as of 12/31/11 for 21 games or more. If none,
 - b. Highest Average with 9 games or more as of 3/15/12. If none,
 - c. Highest current average with minimum of 9 games at time of competition. If none,
 - d. Highest Average from previous winter season for 21 games or 2010-2011. If none,
 - e. Bowler will bowl scratch -200
 All bowlers with a sport league average will use USBC chart for adjusted average.
10. **CHECK-IN:** The bowler must check in one hour prior to the scheduled bowling time. Participants must present their USBC cards or be certified by their coach. They must wear proper bowling attire at check in (See Rule 19).
11. **COMPETITION:** Three games must be bowled per event.
12. **LINE-UP:** Tournament entrants must bowl in the order in which their names appear on the entry form. Rule 324a will not apply, No Changes in submitted lineups. In case of substitution, the substitute must take the place vacated by the absent member. Once a substitute has begun practice, he/she shall be allowed to finish the series.
13. **SUBSTITUTES:** Washington State USBC will not be responsible for filling vacant positions. WSUSBC will work with the host association to maintain a substitute list but will not guarantee substitutes.
14. **COACHING:** Coaching of participants in the settee area during tournament play will not be allowed.
15. **AWARDS:** One out of every ten (10) entries or major fraction thereof, in each division will receive awards. In case of a tie, duplicate awards shall be given.

16. All Events awards will be presented to the bowler in each division (division will be based on singles entry) with the highest 9-game total. First series in Team event & doubles plus Singles will count toward All Events total. Only 1st place will receive an award. \$250 scholarships will be awarded to the Boy and Girl All Events Handicap Champion in each division. \$100 scholarships will be awarded to 1st place in Team, Doubles and Singles events. All scholarship monies will be deposited with, managed by and in accordance with the rules of the S.M.A.R.T. program under acct#10152
17. **CONDUCT GUIDELINES:** These rules apply to participants:
 - a. No use of tobacco products or consumption of alcoholic beverages.
 - b. No use of profane language or gestures.
 - c. Bowlers shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner, not interfering with other bowlers or displaying disruptive behaviors towards bowling equipment.
 - d. No sharing of bowling equipment on the same squad.
 - e. **Cell phones must be turned off or set to silent/vibrate mode.**
 - f. **No electronic devices on the approach**
 - g. **Equipment must not promote alcohol, tobacco, or gambling. (Rule 319b)**
Tournament official will give one verbal warning to violator(s). Further violations could result in immediate disqualification and will be at the discretion of the tournament official. Coaches will be notified of all misconduct complaints and violations by a tournament official.
18. **CLOTHING GUIDELINES: Bowlers must check-in wearing appropriate bowling attire and continue with that bowling attire without making alterations throughout their event or be subject to disqualification.** Competitors shall provide their own bowling shirt with a collar or mock collar. Mock collar must be a minimum of ¾ of one inch. The USBC youth jersey bowling shirt is acceptable. All shirts must have finished sleeves. **Shirts with sleeves cut off, torn, or ripped may not be worn.** Shirts provided by a bowling center are acceptable for the **Youth State Championship Tournament ONLY.** Writing on, or defacing of the bowling shirt will **not** be permitted at any time. Bowling shirts must **not** advertise alcohol or tobacco products or have suggestive gestures. **Full-length pants/slacks** will be allowed for all participants. **Denim** material of any color will be allowed provided they have no holes from wear or holes in newly purchased pants. **(For Youth State Championship Tournament ONLY).** Skirts/skortts, walking shorts (Bermuda shorts) and Capri pants will be allowed. Skirts/skortts must be within 2 inches of the knee. **All apparel** worn by competitors must be proper fitting and not made of fleece or Lucra/spandex-like material. **(Baggy pants below the waist are not acceptable.)** **Head covering or sunglasses cannot be worn during tournament competition.**
19. **PROTESTS:** Appeal or protest regarding tournament scores shall be made in writing to Tournament management within 72 hours. Telescores/printouts used in play shall be saved for 72 hours following squad times. Tournament Official decides disputes occurring on the lanes.
20. **SPECTATOR CONDUCT:** No Flash photography or lighted video cameras will be allowed once tournament play has begun. **Alcohol consumption behind the participants is not allowed.**
21. **SCHEDULING** will be under the direction of the Tournament management. Three dates of preference are requested; however requests DO NOT reserve the date. If space is not available on a requested date, the next open time is given, unless the box is checked to return the fees. Teams from the host association will be scheduled to fill squads.
22. **REFUND DEADLINE:** When an alternate time other than that requested has been assigned and the entrant has been notified of the new time, the entrant has two weeks from postmark date on the confirmation form to refuse the alternate time. Entry fees shall not be refunded after that time. (USBC Rule 314)
23. **OPTIONAL USBC JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFYING EVENT:** Any Junior Gold member may compete in the qualifying event. A Separate Entry form will be used for this event with an additional fee.
24. **All Credit Card entries will be \$17 per person per event, cash entries will be \$16 per person per event.**
