Washington State Youth Championship Tournament Rules

Entries Close Midnight, April 1, 2019

1. USBC Youth Division rules and regulations will govern the tournament. All entrants must be eligible under USBC Rule 400.
2. ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per person/per event, [\\$23/event by credit card.](#)
3. TEAMS: All teams shall be composed of four members. Bowlers may bowl team event unlimited times, but must change two members each time. Mixed entries are allowed and classified according to average. All entries must list and pay for four members. No partial teams accepted. No team member may switch teams unless the team he/she comes from is dissolved.
4. DOUBLES AND SINGLES: Bowlers may bowl singles or doubles or both. Bowlers may bowl unlimited times in doubles event, but must change partners each time. All double entries must list and pay for two members. Bowlers may bowl unlimited times in singles event, but can place only once in singles.
5. OPTIONAL SCRATCH SINGLES: Bowlers have the option of paying an additional \$5 prize fund fee for scratch singles. Payouts will be based on one out of every six (6) entries or major fraction thereof.
6. HANDICAP: Handicap will be based on 100% of 220.
7. PAYMENT: No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by a check or money order for the full amount due on the entry and made payable to the Washington State USBC or processed online. **Advance Reservations will be accepted until January 31, 2019 and must be paid by February 1, 2019 in order to keep said reservation.**
8. ENTRY DATES: All entries must be postmarked no later than the first business day after April 1, 2019, and include full payment or they will not be accepted. Returned checks shall be subject to a \$35.00 service charge. Funds must be secured on any returned check prior to the start of the tournament; otherwise, bowler(s) paying by such check will not be allowed to participate.
9. **ENTERING AVERAGE: The average to be used for this tournament will be in the order of:**
 - a. Highest Average with minimum 21 games as of December 31, 2018. **Must submit average sheet. If none,**
 - b. Highest Average with minimum 21 games as of March 1, 2019. **Must submit average sheet. If none,**
 - c. Highest current average with minimum of 12 games at the time of bowling state tournament. **Must submit average sheet. If none,**
 - d. All other Bowlers will bowl scratch – 220 average

All bowlers with a challenge or sport league average only will use the appropriate USBC chart for adjusted average to determine high book average.
10. CHECK-IN: The bowler must check in one hour prior to the scheduled bowling time. Participants must present their USBC cards or be certified by their coach. They must wear proper bowling attire at check in (See Rule 19).
11. COMPETITION: Three games must be bowled per event.
12. LINE-UP: Tournament entrants must bowl in the order in which their names appear on the entry form. Rule 324a will not apply. In case of a substitution, the substitute must take the place vacated by the absent member. Once a substitute has begun a game, he/she shall be allowed to finish the series.
13. SUBSTITUTES: Washington State USBC will not be responsible for filling vacant positions. WSUSBC will work with the host association to maintain a substitute list but will not guarantee substitutes.
14. COACHING: Coaching of participants in the settee area during tournament play will not be allowed. Coaching may occur above the settee area as long as it does not slow down the pace of play.
15. AWARDS: One out of every six (6) entries or major fraction thereof, in each division will receive awards (SMART money and certificate). In case of a tie, duplicate awards shall be given. All scholarship monies will be deposited with, managed by and in accordance with the rules of the SMART program. First place winners will also receive a plaque.
16. ALL EVENTS AWARDS: will be presented to the bowler in each division with the highest 9-game total. (division will be based on singles average) First series in team, doubles, and singles events will count toward the All

- Events total. Only 1st place will receive an award. \$150 scholarships will be awarded to the All Events Handicap Champion in each division.
17. SCRATCH ALL EVENT OPTION: Bowlers have the option of paying an additional \$5 prize fund fee to enter scratch all events. Payout will be based on one out of every twelve (12) entries or major fraction thereof.
 18. CONDUCT GUIDELINES: These rules apply to participants:
 - a. No use of tobacco products or consumption of alcoholic beverages.
 - b. No use of profane language or gestures.
 - c. Bowlers shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner.
 - d. No sharing of bowling equipment on the same squad.
 - e. The use of cell phones or electronic devices is not allowed during tournament play. All devices must be turned off or set to silent/vibrate mode.
 - f. Equipment or clothing must not promote alcohol, tobacco, or gambling. (Rule 319b)

Tournament official will give one verbal warning to violator(s). Further violations could result in immediate disqualification and will be at the discretion of the tournament official. Coaches will be notified of all misconduct complaints and violations by a tournament official.
 19. CLOTHING GUIDELINES:
 - a. Bowlers must check in wearing appropriate bowling attire and continue with that bowling attire without alterations throughout their event or be subject to disqualification.
 - b. Competitors shall provide their own bowling shirt with a collar. The USBC youth jersey bowling shirt is acceptable
 - c. Boys shall wear pants/slacks, or walking shorts.
 - d. Girls shall wear pants/slacks, skorts, walking shorts (Bermuda shorts) or Capri pants.
 - e. Gym shorts, sweat pants and clothing made of fleece or Lycra/spandex-like material ARE NOT allowed.
 - f. All apparel worn by competitors must be proper fitting.
 - g. Shirts provided by a bowling center or by a certified bowling manufacturer (such as Storm, Hammer, etc.) are acceptable.
 - h. Denim material of any color (jeans) will be allowed provided they have no holes from wear or holes in newly purchased pants.

The Tournament Manager or Event Manager must approve any/all exceptions before the event. The decision of the Tournament Official will be final.
 20. PROTESTS: Appeal or protest regarding tournament scores shall be made in writing to Tournament Management within 72 hours. Telescopes/Printouts used in play shall be saved for 72 hours following squad times. Tournament official decides disputes occurring on the lanes.
- Alcohol consumption behind the participants is not allowed.
21. SCHEDULING will be under the direction of the Tournament management. Two dates of preference are requested; however, requests DO NOT reserve the date. If space is not available on a requested date, the next open time is given. Teams from the host association will be scheduled to fill squads. **Money must be received within ten (10) days after reservation has been made to keep the reserved spot.**
 22. REFUND DEADLINE: When an alternate time other than that requested has been assigned and the entrant has been notified of the new time, the entrant has two weeks from postmark date on the confirmation form to refuse the alternate time. Entry fees shall not be refunded after that time. (USBC Rule 314)
